## KEY STAGE 2 READING

Children in KS2 are able to change their reading book on any day of the week and it is the child's responsibility to ask to do this. When the class has their weekly quiet reading session (Tuesdays), teachers will remind children to change their books if they have not done so recently. This reading session happens in addition to whole class guided reading lessons which are three times per week. If your child has been reading a book for a few days and feels that the book is not for them or they are not enjoying the book, they can change it without finishing the book. (It is okay, and perfectly normal, to occasionally begin a book and then decide not to continue with it). For year 3 parents, please ensure you sign their reading record each time they read at home. Year 4 children can take responsibility for writing this in themselves, but please do check it is done. If your child is a confident, fluent reader, they will most likely be reading silently to themselves, but please talk with them about what they have read.
