

Involving Parents and Carers

Last week we continued with our story Jack and the Beanstalk. We were thinking about the different characters in the story and have been using role-play to understand how the characters were feeling.

Within our hall time we thought about what the giant looked like and used lots of words to describe how big he is e.g. huge, enormous and gigantic. We thought about how the giant moves and why e.g. slowly because he is heavy. As the children shared their ideas we acted out being the giant from the story.

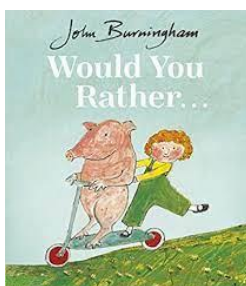


We also ventured into the Woodland area to act out the story. All the children had an opportunity to take part and chose what characters they wanted to be. We made a recording of it. Look on the school website under Nursery.

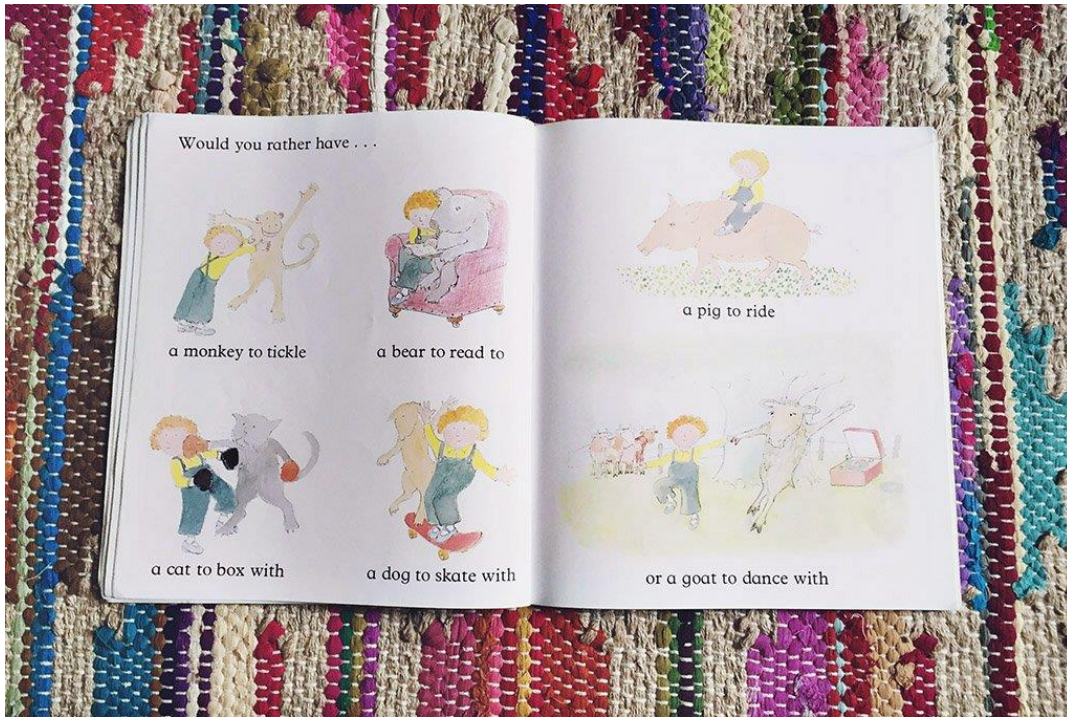
In maths we have been ordering numbers to 5 (or 10) and counting the correct number of seeds to match the numeral. The numbers were written on leaves and the children had to order them correctly up the beanstalk.



We have continued with lots of planting again. Unfortunately the snails have been enjoying the lovely fresh leaves of the sunflowers. However, the children were more than happy to plant more seeds. Look at how our seeds have grown into little plants.



This week we have been reading a book called 'Would You Rather...'. As we read through the book the children were encouraged to make a choice. We modelled the sentence 'I would rather...'. We made links to the children's own experiences. You can play 'would you rather...' games at home. Discuss these with your child and share your responses and ideas too. Here are a few favourite pages from the book.



We have been singing 'I'm a Little Teapot'. Ask your child if they can perform it for you.
