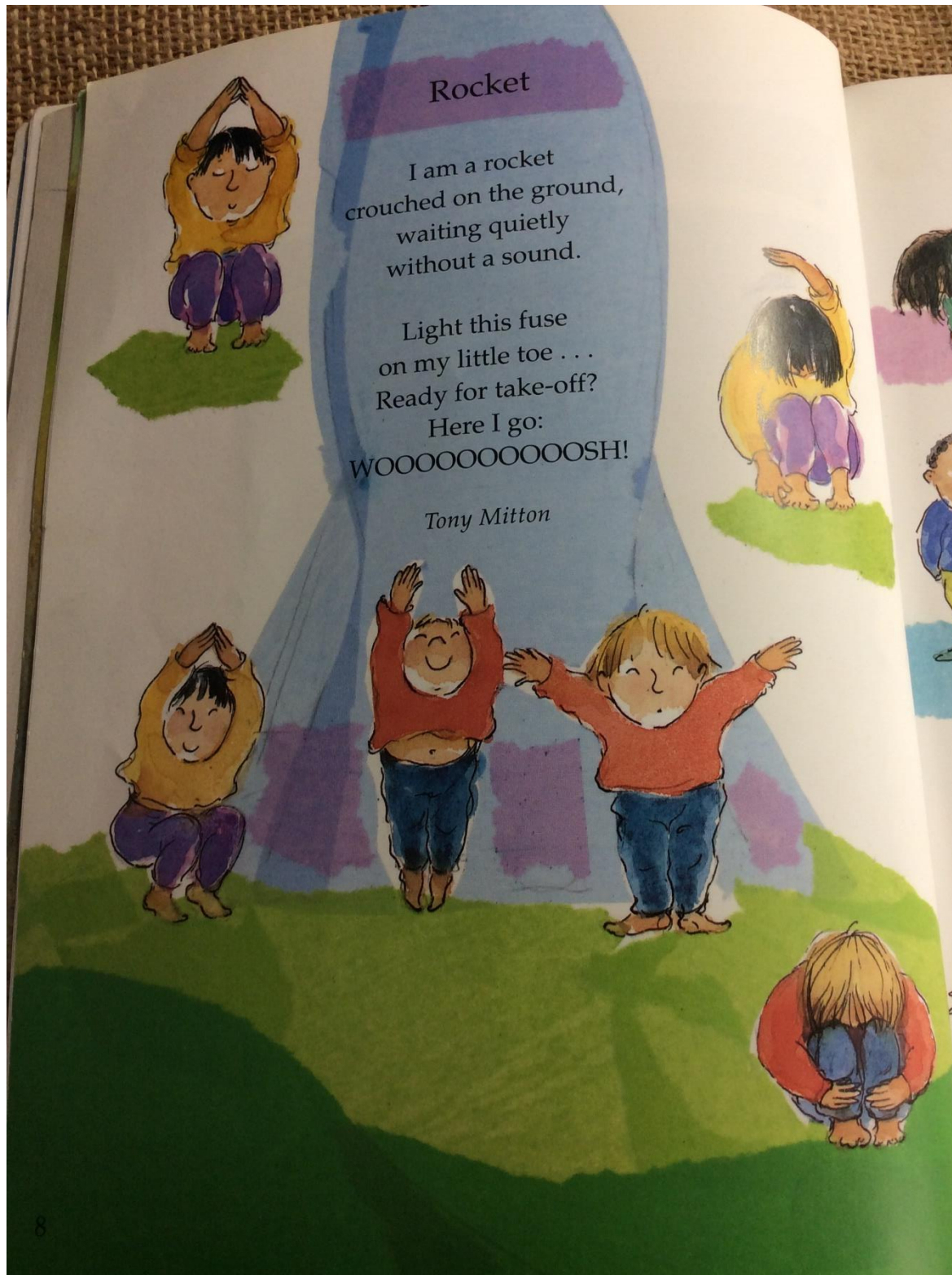
The children explored musical instruments that could be banged, tapped, shaken, clashed or scraped. As the children explored playing the instruments we talked about how to make a loud or quiet sound.



We have been singing lots of Nursery Rhymes.

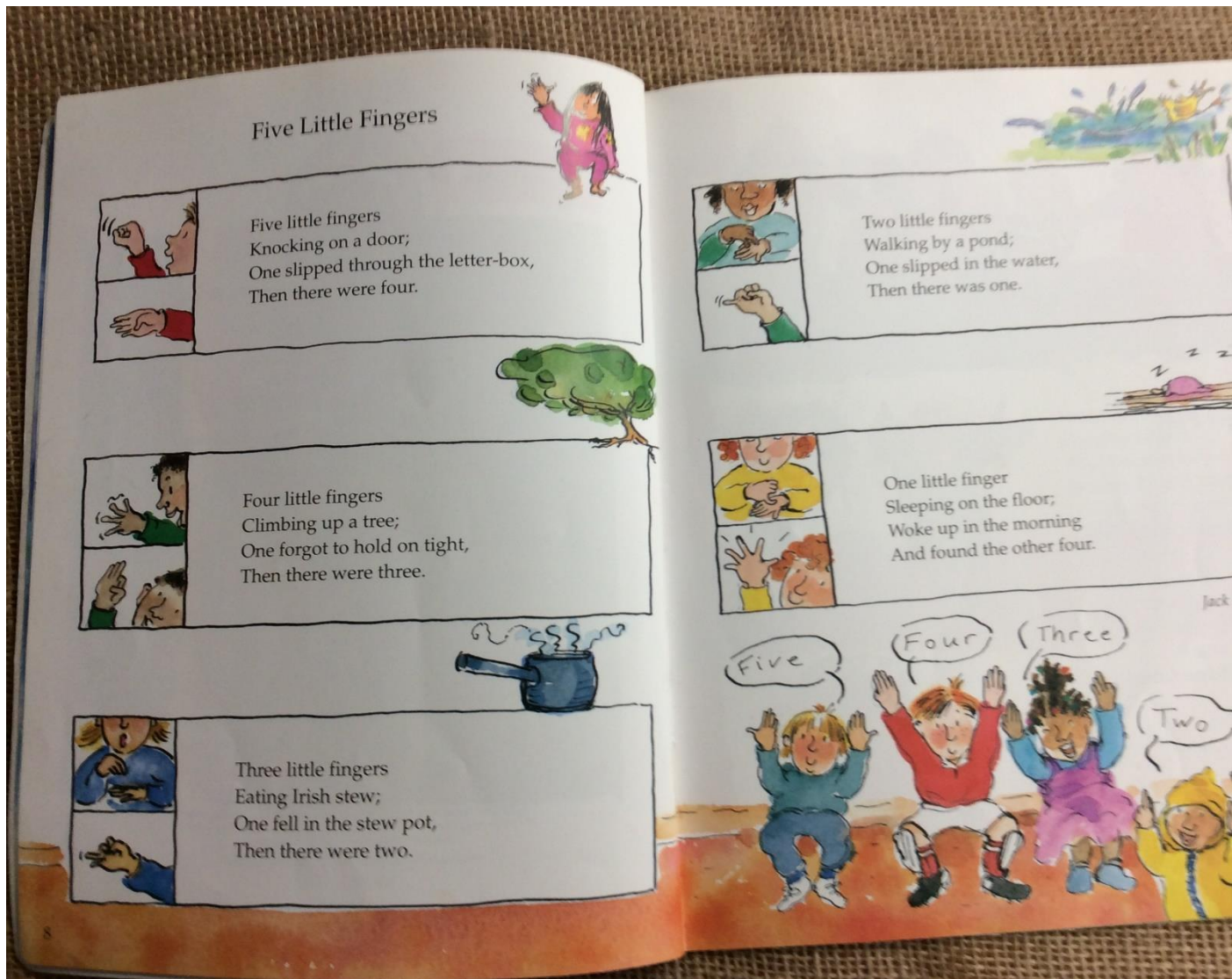
