### ADVICE FROM HERFORDSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL

For all pupils who live with someone who has tested positive for Covid-19, reception age or above, it is recommended they should take an LFD test every day for 7 days.

Anyone who develops Covid-19 symptoms should isolate immediately and book a PCR test.

If pupils are feeling unwell with other symptoms they should stay off school until well enough to return.
