



MORNING ROUTINE FOR KS1 AND KS2

Children in Years 3 & 4 who have a younger sibling in Years 1 or 2 will be allowed to enter class at 8.45am. All other children in Years 3 & 4 should not arrive until 8.50am. For parents with children in all three key stages, we suggest arriving at 8.50am.
