### GIFTS

### REMINDER

If anyone in your household gets COVID symptoms, everyone in the household must self-isolate and arrange a test for the member who has symptoms. Children must not return to school unless that member has a negative result, or in the case of a positive result until the 14-day self-isolation period has ended. Results of tests should be emailed to school with URGENT in the subject bar. If your child has been asked to self-isolate due to bubble closure, they return on the date given. Children who are self-isolating must get tested if they develop symptoms and must not go out during this period. If your child is generally unwell and you are not sure whether to get them tested, please contact 111 for advice. Children do get lots of colds and coughs at this time of year, but it is better to be cautious and keep them at home if unwell.
