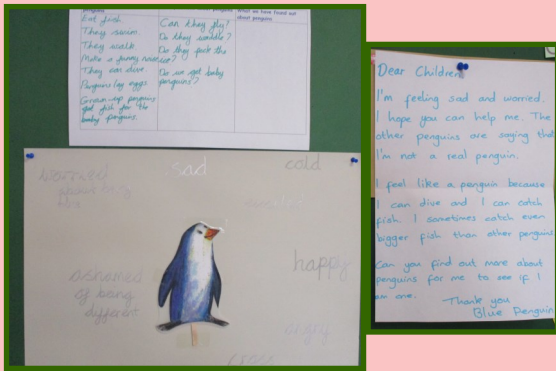




OTTERS WRITE TO THE BLUE PENGUIN IN ANTARCTICA...
