ZONES OF REGULATION

This term, throughout the school, we have been introducing the 'Zones of Regulation', a strategy to help children recognise their feelings and to learn ways to help them regulate their behaviour and return to the happy, calm 'green zone'.

To help children understand the four different zones and the associated feelings, we have been using books to stimulate class discussions and to support them to make connections with their own feelings.

We thought we'd share a couple of books in case you want to check them out online or from the local library.

Red Zone - anger, frustration, fear

Ravi's Roar by Tom Percival

Tom Percival is a master at making colourful, enjoyable picture books about big emotions. In this story we meet Ravi who can usually control his emotions. However, one day lots of little events happen that mean that Ravi can't contain his feelings anymore and he turns into a roaring tiger!



Yellow Zone - worry, anxiety, over-excitement

Jabari Jumps by Gaia Cornwall

This is a beautifully illustrated, father-son story evoking summers by the pool. Jabari is trying to find the courage to take his first leap off the diving board. The story shows that it is ok to be scared when faced with a new challenge but sometimes good things can come when we push ourselves out of our comfort zone.



Blue Zone - sadness, loneliness, tiredness

When Sadness Comes to Call by Eva Eland

This amazing picture book explains sadness in a child-friendly way and discusses ways to understand and cope with the emotion. Sadness is personified as a blob-like character who turns up unexpectedly into a child's life. Rather than ignore sadness, the book teaches children to try and understand their feeling and suggests what they can do when sadness visits: listen to music with it, go outdoors for a walk, drink hot chocolate
