

Roman Way First School Pupil Premium Plan for 2017 - 2018

The Pupil Premium Grant (PPG) has been awarded to schools since April 2011. For the current academic year (2017-18) primary schools will receive a sum of £1320 for any child who had been in receipt of free school meals (FSM) any time during the last 6 years.

Additionally, children who are, or have been in care (CLA) are supported by a grant of £1900. Why is it important? The PPG is used to address underlying difficulties faced by some families. Our school uses the grant in a variety of ways to suit the individual needs of each child in receipt of the grant and help them to achieve their potential.

Roman Way First School funding allocation for Pupil Premium is £69960 based on 53 pupils eligible.

Funding is planned as follows:

- Family and child support worker (3 days a week)
- TA for reading interventions
- TA for SALT (Speech & Language Therapy)
- TA for intervention support
- Art and Music Therapy
- Inside lunch club for those with the social and emotional needs
- Training for staff on new interventions for pupils
- Additional support materials and resources
- Subsidised trips and activities
- After school clubs
- Uniform grants
- Behaviour Support Team (North Herts Education Support Centre)
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Funding will be used in the ways listed above to support pupil progress and attainment and to continue interventions to diminish differences. Each child is identified on their individual provision map with personalised learning programmes and their progress and development monitored by the SENCo and Senior Leadership team.
