<p>Outcomes:</p> <p>Phonics:</p> <p>Y1 phonics: 75% of disadvantaged pupils in the cohort met the expected standard.</p> <p>Y2 phonics: 80% of disadvantaged pupils in the cohort met the expected standard.</p> <p>KS1/KS2</p> <p>Reading: 64% of disadvantaged pupils in the cohort made expected or better progress.</p> <p>Writing: 72% of disadvantaged pupils in the cohort made expected or better progress.</p> <p>Maths: 86% of disadvantaged pupils in the cohort made expected or better progress.</p>	
Curriculum focus of PPG spending 2016-2017	
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ➤ Developing self-esteem and self-confidence in identified pupils to enable them to access the whole curriculum e.g. 1:1 work with Family Support Worker, Silver SEAL (Social, Emotional Aspects of Learning) sessions. ➤ Small group interventions to support pupils in English and maths with a focus on core basic skills. ➤ Individual interventions e.g. Speech & Language ➤ Opportunities for pupils to learn to play the Recorder, Keyboard or Ukulele.
