

Year 1 Learning Overview Weeks 21st Nov. – 9th Dec. 2022

English	We are looking at capital letter formation and when to use these in our writing to indicate the start of a sentence and for proper nouns.
Maths	We are continuing to consolidate our learning of addition and subtraction using a variety of methods. We will use counting objects and number lines to calculate more and less.
Science	We are continuing to learn about the human body and the five senses. We will be learning about our tongue and the sense of taste and our hands and the sense of touch.
PE	Team building: We are continuing to learn to follow instructions and work with others to co-operate, communicate, create a plan and solve challenges. We have been working on silent communication.
History and Geography	We are learning more about the events of the Great Fire of London and how life is different in the present from the past. We are using this topic to explore the geography of the UK, locating the countries and capital cities.
Art	We are continuing to use mixed media such as paint and oil pastel and use different skills such as drawing, painting, weaving and collage to create our royal self-portraits.
Handwriting	We are learning to form the letters: f, l, j, v, w, x.
Phonics	We are continuing with Phase 5 of Little Wandle Letters and Sounds. Focus graphemes will be /ee/ e-e these, /oo/ /yoo/ ew chew new, /ee/ ie shield, /or/ aw claw. New tricky words: house, mouse, water, want.
