

## Year 1 Learning Overview Weeks 6<sup>th</sup> to 16<sup>th</sup> June 2023

<b>English</b>	We are reading a variety of texts that give instructions and then planning and writing our own. We are then moving on to reading 'Dear Teacher' by Amy Husband and learning about the conventions of letter writing.
<b>Maths</b>	<b>Place Value (50-100):</b> We are learning to count from 50-100. We are also learning to recognise how many tens and ones each of those numbers are made of. We are practising finding one more and one less of each number.
<b>Science</b>	<b>Everyday Materials:</b> We are continuing to learn about materials (wood, metal, plastic, etc.) and their properties. We are predicting and investigating which materials will be the most wind-resistant and waterproof to build a structure from.
<b>PE</b>	<b>Athletics:</b> We are learning about running, jumping and throwing and practising these skills.
<b>Computing</b>	<b>Coding:</b> We are learning to describe and use instructions to program a character and program a character to grow and shrink.
<b>History</b>	<b>Sun, Sea and Sandcastles:</b> We are learning to describe what a seaside holiday is like at the present time and compare the similarities and differences between the seaside holidays in the early 1950s and now.
<b>Design and Technology</b>	<b>Wheels and Axles:</b> We are learning to understand how wheels move and describe the materials used and we will also identify what stops wheels from turning and solve problems.
<b>PSHE</b>	<b>Changing Me:</b> We are learning about the different stages of life of humans and how our bodies change over time. We are also thinking about how our abilities change as we get older.
<b>Handwriting</b>	We are focussing on getting correct letter orientation, making sure that letters such as 'b', 'd', 'f' and 's' are the right way round. We are also practising the correct formation and use of capital letters for the beginning of sentences, names, months and days of the week
