

## Year 1 Learning Overview Weeks 9<sup>th</sup> Jan 2023 – 20<sup>th</sup> Jan 2023

<b>English</b>	We are learning about the features of a character description and then we will be writing our own description of a character from a book we are reading.
<b>Maths</b>	<b>Place Value</b> - We are learning the place value of numbers beyond 10, up to 20. We are learning that these numbers are made of 1 'ten' and some 'ones' and that 20 is made of 2 'tens'. We are practising counting forwards and backwards within 0-20.
<b>Science</b>	<b>Animals, including Humans</b> - We are learning to sort and classify the 5 different classes of animal (mammals, reptiles, amphibians, fish and birds) based on their physical characteristics.
<b>PE</b>	<b>Gymnastics:</b> We are learning to use shapes to create balances; to link travelling actions and balances using apparatus; to demonstrate different shapes, take off and landings when performing jumps and develop rolling and sequence building.
<b>Geography</b>	<b>Our Local Area:</b> We are learning to recognise physical and human geographical features around our school through fieldwork.
<b>Art</b>	We are learning about how colour is used in art. We are mixing primary colours (red, blue, yellow) to make secondary colours (orange, purple, green). We are also looking at landscapes and completing observational drawings of our school.
<b>PSHE</b>	<b>Dreams and Goals:</b> We are learning to set goals and identify steps towards achieving them. We will focus on persevering even when we find tasks difficult and be able to work with a partner.
<b>RE</b>	We are learning about community. We are focussing on what it means to be part of different types of community and how people in a Christian community worship.
