

Year 2 Learning Overview Weeks 20th February – 3rd March 2023

English	We are learning about the features of traditional stories and setting description. We will write our own setting description and character description of traditional stories we are reading.
Maths	Multiplication and Division: We are learning about 5- and 10-times tables and understand that division is the inverse of multiplication. Length & Height: We are learning to measure, compare and order lengths and heights in centimetres and metres and solve problems involving measuring lengths and heights.
Science	Plants: We are learning to identify the difference between bulbs and seeds and their properties. We will design an experiment to find out what plants need to grow.
PE	Yoga: We are learning to copy and repeat yoga poses, to develop an awareness of strength and flexibility when completing yoga poses and copy and remember actions linking them into a flow.
Geography	Our Local Area: We are learning to do a fieldwork to investigate the different modes of transport that use the road near our school.
Computing	Animated story books: We are learning to understand the differences between traditional books and e-books and to add animation to a picture.
History	Our local area: We are learning to identify how has Royston town changed over the last 70 years.
D&T	Breadmaking: We are learning about the journey of breadmaking from sowing the seeds in a farm to a baked bread. We will also investigate and evaluate existing products (a variety of breads) according to their characteristics.
PSHE	Healthy Me: We are learning to know what we need to keep our body healthy. To understand what relaxed and stressed means and identify things that make us feel relaxed and some that make us feel stressed.
